- Commercial & Business entries MUST BE A FLOAT or decorated truck or an amazing walking group.
- Each entry must be submitted on an official parade entry form.
- Only one entry per application.

• Floats, Decorated Cars/Trucks & Other Entries:

- All final judging will be done at the Viewing Stand.
- All floats must be built and delivered to the Route intact.
- Floats to be pulled by tractors furnished by the applicants with a farm-type hitch & pin (Not a ball type)
- Floats must be picked up/removed immediately following parade.

• All Animal & Equestrian Units and Single Animal Entries

- Equestrian units must furnish their own clean-up crew.
- CLEAN-UP CREW MUST <u>IMMEDIATELY</u> FOLLOW THE UNIT AT ALL TIMES STARTING AT LINE-UP.
- Clean-up begins at line up.
- At least one clean-up person for every five horses.
- Clean-up includes waiting time before and AFTER parade.
